

INSTALLATION AND USER MANUAL FOR STARFLEX MODULAR STORAGE AND SHELF SYSTEM (CONSUMER)

1. Product Information

The Starflex modular storage and shelf system is developed for use in motorhomes, but can also be used in garages, commercial premises, trucks, vans, trailers, basements, sheds and other storage environments. The system is proudly manufactured in Norway from high-strength 6082-T6 aluminium, with extruded profiles and final assembly in Sandefjord. The products combine low weight with high strength and can be adapted for many purposes.

2. Important Safety Instructions

- Read this manual carefully before installation and use.
- Do not exceed the maximum load per rail (50 kg with correct installation).
- Always check the wall/substrate for hidden cables, pipes or other installations before drilling or screwing.
- Always use suitable tools and personal protective equipment during installation.
- The system is not designed to carry people or to be used as a climbing frame.
- When used in vehicles: note that objects may shift during driving.

3. Before You Start

Plan the placement of the rails carefully before installation. A full installation in a motorhome with 10–16 rails normally takes about 1.5 hours, but allow at least as much time for planning. Best results are achieved with centre-to-centre spacing between rails of 220–270 mm, and not exceeding 320 mm if you wish to use all types of accessories.

4. Installation

Install the modular rails vertically, with the largest diameter of the keyhole at the top. Rails can be cut to the desired length, preferably at the bottom. We recommend using the supplied screws (4.8x13 mm) to avoid damaging hidden installations. For carpeted or thicker walls, longer screws can be used. Alternatively, the rails may be glued with Tec7 or equivalent, but this is not recommended if the rail may need to be removed later.

5. Use

The system can be used to store a wide variety of equipment such as boxes, hooks, bicycle holders, telescopic tubes and custom-made solutions. Equipment requiring two rails can be adjusted sideways thanks to sliding grooves in the locking system. Do not use the system for purposes for which it is not intended.

6. Maintenance

Inspect the system for wear and damage at least twice a year, or more frequently with heavy use. Clean with mild soapy water and avoid aggressive chemicals. Replace damaged components immediately.

7. Warranty

Starflex AS provides a 2-year warranty for consumers, in accordance with the Norwegian Consumer Purchases Act and EU Directive 1999/44/EC on consumer sales. The warranty is valid from the date of purchase and covers manufacturing and material defects under normal use. The warranty does not cover damage resulting from incorrect installation, unauthorised modification, overloading or misuse. Claims must be submitted in writing with proof of purchase.

8. Limitation of Liability

Starflex AS is not liable for damage to persons, property or vehicles resulting from incorrect installation, modification of the product or use outside the specified purpose, in accordance with the Norwegian Product Liability Act and EU Directive 85/374/EEC. Installation and use are at the customer's own risk and must always be carried out in accordance with this manual.
